














YUYU Transformative Education


Children become river heroes in 4 steps Half-day or full-day program in groups of 5-6 children

1. Inspire



Children become aware of how river pollution is damaging river biodiversity and are inspired to make a change.

2. Explore



Children explore and investigate the condition of their local river in hands-on river assignments, like water quality sampling or river waste collecting.

3. Create



Children co-create a 1 min. video presentation of their river assignment outcomes. What did they discover and learn about their local river?

4. Connect



Children share their presentations on a worldwide accessible YUYU platform. From all over the world. children can compare their findings, connect and interact.
















Connecting children along rivers around the world


